The 1992 Olympic Dream Team was just that: the greatest team ever assembled. The roster was made up of Michael Jordan, Magic Johnson, Larry Bird, Charles Barkley, Karl Malone, John Stockton, Patrick Ewing, David Robinson, Clyde Drexler, Scottie Pippen, Chris Mullin, and Christian Laettner. All the members of the Dream Team (except Christian Laettner) will be or already are in the Hall of Fame as individual. Tonight they will be honored by being inducted into the Hall of Fame as a team. The timing of the team was important as well. It came after the 1988 US Olympic Basketball team was the first not to win the gold in basketball.

The team had the greatest player of all time—Michael Jordan. They had the greatest point guard of all time—Magic Johnson. They had two of the top 5 power forwards of all time—Karl Malone and Charles Barkley, and they had two of the best centers—Patrick Ewing and David Robinson. The Dream Team thoroughly dominated every game they played winning all five of its group games by an average of 46 points. They scored 110 points in every game aside from the gold medal game in which they had 103. They were able to beat a good Croatian team led by Tony Kukoc and Drazen Petrovic in the gold medal game by 32, which was the

The beauty of it was that the way they integrated all their stardom and personalities to create a flawless display of teamwork. Even though they had MJ and Bird, two of the most prolific scorers in NBA history, it was Charles Barkley who led the team in scoring. Coach Chuck Daly never had to call a timeout. The team gelled together even though they were accustomed to competing against one another. There was never conflict, only greatness. The 2008 "Redeem Team" would not have been able to beat the 1992 Dream Team (although basketball fans can only dream of the matchup). As great as the 2008 team

The Dream Team began its campaign with a thunderous victory over Angola, decimating them by a score of 116 to 48. This performance set the tone for the rest of the Games as Michael Jordan and company steamrolled over opponents, who were sometimes mere spectators in the match as a team of superstars went about their business. Daily apathy characterised the team in a 2019 interview with NBA.com: "It was like Elvis and the Beatles put together. Travelling with the Dream Team was like travelling with 12 rock stars. That's all I can compare it to." After Angola, Croatia, Germany, Brazil and Spain were brushed aside by an imperious



BRZO Chrome Away

In a team that comprised Michael Jordan, Larry Bird and Magic Johnson, it was Charles Barkley who emerged as the team's leading scorer with 18 points per game. Jordan, at his brilliant best, produced several moments of magic that gave the world a glimpse of one of the greatest athletes of all time. The then Bulls' shooting guard finished the 1992 Barcelona Games with a PPG (points per game) of 14.9 and set the record for most assists in a single Olympic game (12) against Germany. Co-captains of the team Bird and Johnson put in performances that were quintessentially charismatic and showed why they belonged in the
